#### Experience is our hallmark

Our company boasts a copious list of water and wastewater infrastructure projects, including the largest self-performed contract in our history: construction of the Vineyard Surface Water Treatment Plant in California. The Sacramento County Water Agency tapped Balfour Beatty Infrastructure for the \$207 million project. In addition to the plant itself, the company is building the agency's Freeport Water Intake Facility. Balfour Beatty Infrastructure's work at this site also entails a 24-million-gallon contact tank, a 7,000 HP treated pump station and several buildings on the site. The project is set for completion in 2011.

The Folsom South Canal Connection project in Northern California, which opened in 2010, included construction of two plants that pump 100 million gallons per day. The \$93 million project called for two electrical substations, more than 3,700 linear feet of steel pipeline, 20 miles of fiber-optic cable and associated roadways.

#### Our project list also includes:

- The new Sunnyside Wastewater Treatment Plant in Lake Stevens, Wash. The \$89 million contract with the Lake Stevens Sewer District runs through 2011. Balfour Beatty Infrastructure is constructing the 5 million gallon-per-day plant, which includes a wastewater receiving area, an aeration system and an ultraviolet disinfection system.
- The new Dry Creek Wastewater Treatment Plant, including construction of an ultraviolet disinfection system and demolition of chlorine gas facilities.
- The Roseville Water Treatment Plant in Roseville, Calif., which increased capacity from 60 million



gallons per day to 100 million. Balfour Beatty Infrastructure finished the job ahead of schedule.

- The expansion and upgrade of the E.A. Fairbairn Treatment Plant near Sacramento, Calif., which boosted capacity from 80 million gallons per day to 160 million.
- Waterworks modernization, along with a new pumping stations for the City of Cleveland.

#### High marks for safety, the environment

Safety is a high priority in our water and wastewater infrastructure work. The many awards we've received from the Occupational Safety and Health Administration are a testimony of our success. Care for the environment is also a non-negotiable component of Balfour Beatty Infrastructure's philosophy.
